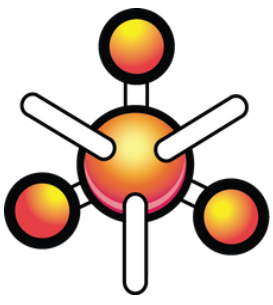


WHERE AUROS IQ CAN HELP

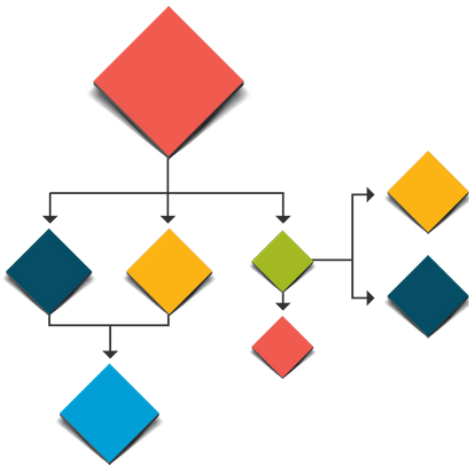
Examples:

Where Standard Work Exists



Whenever multiple people or teams perform rigorous work, it's important to stay consistent across projects and share best practices.

Examples:

- Business and project templates
- Standard procedures
